

MFL at OJS

We will continue to offer a broad and balanced curriculum however some elements of the Modern Foreign Languages curriculum have been tightened in response to COVID 19. During this time, to ensure the safety of our pupils and staff we have adapted this subject by taking physical distancing and sharing of resources into account.

We:

- ventilate rooms well.
- seat children side by side, facing the same direction.
- avoid large gatherings - school assemblies will take place through invites to Teams conferencing.
- avoid crossing of bubbles (including within schools and collaborative events with other schools that would usually take place to share expertise within MFL.)

During Modern Foreign Languages lessons we:

- before and the end of sessions clean hands and surfaces before and after lessons.
- resources will only be shared between bubbles
- children's work will be stored in their learning journals
- children have individual equipment such as scissors, glue, pencils, pens and rulers.
- any other shared equipment will be cleaned before and after use
- any other resources will to distributed individually to children and not shared
- When orally rehearsing new vocabulary, we will use indoor voices and avoid projecting loudly.
