

Sports Premium Funding

The Government provided funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15 and 2015/16 to provide new, substantial primary school sport funding. This funding was jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and saw money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of, and participation in, sport and PE for all their children.

The government have continued this funding for Primary PE and school sport into 2016-2017; meaning primary schools are able to put in place longer term plans to further improve provision.
