We will use our imaginations to be creative and develop our teamwork.


We will develop self-confidence as we learn to look at risk and work safely.

Key Vocabulary and definitions

Spinney	A small wood with undergrowth.
brook	A small natural stream.
natural	Something that is made by nature.
habitat	A place where an animal, mini-beast or plant lives.
species	A group of similar animals, mini-beasts of plants.
respect	Acting in ways to share care for others.
boundaries	The edge of where you are allowed to go - often to keep you safe.
explore	Using your senses to find out about a place.
reflect	Thinking about what you have seen, heard or experienced.
health and safety	Ways of behaving that keep us safe and healthy.
blade	A sharp edge on a knife or peeler.
fuel	Something that makes heat when it is burnt.
oxygen	A gas which we need to live and is needed by fire.
