Grammar

Masculine and feminine nouns (introduced in Aut 1)

mon - masculine my

ma - feminine - my

il - he; elle - she

Nouns

All nouns are either masculine and feminine.

Masculine nouns: we use le or un \rightarrow un nez

Feminine nouns: we use la or une → une tête

Speaking and listening

Formation of long and short sounds

E.g. ai, et / ay \rightarrow j'ai, et

 $des + vowel / dez \rightarrow des oreilles$

 $des + consonent / day \rightarrow des cheveux$
