Grammar

Masculine and feminine nouns
(introduced in Aut 1)

mon – masculine my

ma – feminine – my

il – he ; elle – she

Nouns

All nouns are either
masculine and feminine.

Masculine nouns: we use
le or un → un nez

Feminine nouns: we use la
or une → une tête

Speaking and listening

Formation of long and short sounds

E.g. ai, et / ay → j'ai, et

des + vowel / dez → des oreilles

des + consonant / day → des cheveux

Ma famille – My family

ma mère	My mother
mon père	My father
mon frère	My brother
ma sœur	My sister
ma grand-mère	My grandmother
mon grand-père	My grandfather
