In French, the same word in English can have more than one word in French. For example, the English word **in**.


In French we use dans, en or à, depending on the noun that follows it.

Key Vocabulary

Les temps - weather	
il y a du soleil	it is sunny
il y a du vents	it is windy
il pleut	it rains
il neige	it snows
il fait chaud	it is hot
il fait froid	it is cold

Points cardinaux - compass points

au printemps	in the spring
en été	in the summer
en automne	it the autumn
en hiver	in the winter
