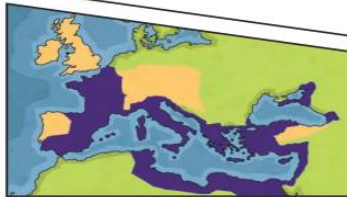


Year 3- Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.

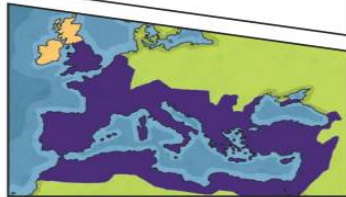
What should I already know?

Invade	To enter a country to occupy it.
Celts	People living in Britain.
Emperor	The ruler of an Empire.
Caledonia	What Scotland was known as during the Roman era.
Picts	Tribes from Caledonia.
Legion	A large section of the Roman Army made up of 5,000 soldiers.
Pagan	A person holding religious beliefs other than those of the main world religions.
