## Tutankhamun Facts

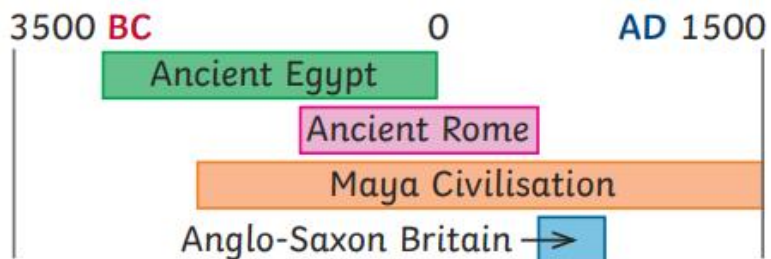
- He was pharaoh from approximately **1333 BC- 1323 BC**
- He was known as the **'boy king'** as he became pharaoh aged 9
- In **1922**, Howard Carter and his team discovered his tomb in the Valley of the Kings
- The tomb contained over **3,000 treasures**
- Tutankhamun died suddenly as the tomb was finished hastily



## Key vocabulary and definitions

Pharaoh	A ruler of Ancient Egypt.
Irrigation	To move water from a river to land or crops to help them grow.
Vizier	An official with a lot of power who served the pharaoh.
Artisans	People that specialise in crafts like stone carving and carpentry.
Hieroglyphs	Pictures and symbols that make up the Egyptian system of writing.
Silt	Small particles of soil, clay or sand carried and left by water.
Preserve	To keep something in its original form.
Mummification	To preserve a body by embalming it and wrapping it in cloth.
Relief	A type of carving or painting that could be found inside tombs and temples.
Sarcophagus	A stone coffin which can be decorated.
