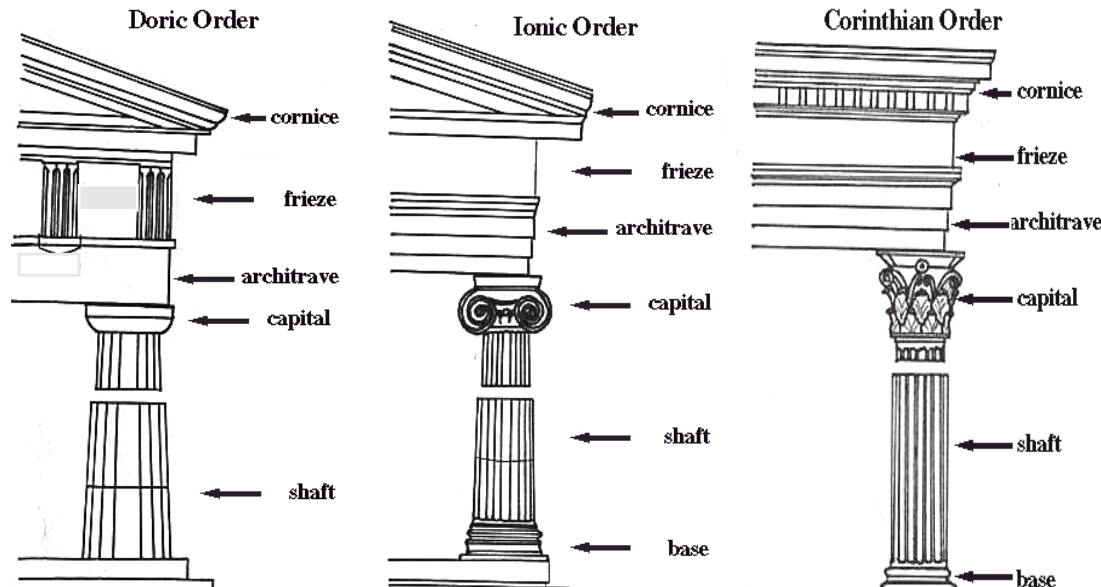


What should I already know?

Key vocabulary and definitions

Archaeologist	Scientists who study the history of humans by looking at what man-made objects were left behind.
Architect	People who design buildings.
Architecture	The art and technique of designing and building.
Depicting	Showing something in a work of art.
Inspiring	Encouraging.
Engineering	Using scientific knowledge to build.
Friezes	Decoration high on a wall.
Pediment	A triangular space that forms the gable of a low-pitched roof- usually filled with sculptures.
Idealised	Perfect or better than in reality.
Perfection	Something that is flawless.
Sculpture	Making 2D/3D objects by carving stone or wood or by casting metal or plaster.
Culture	The ways people practice life and the traditions they observe
