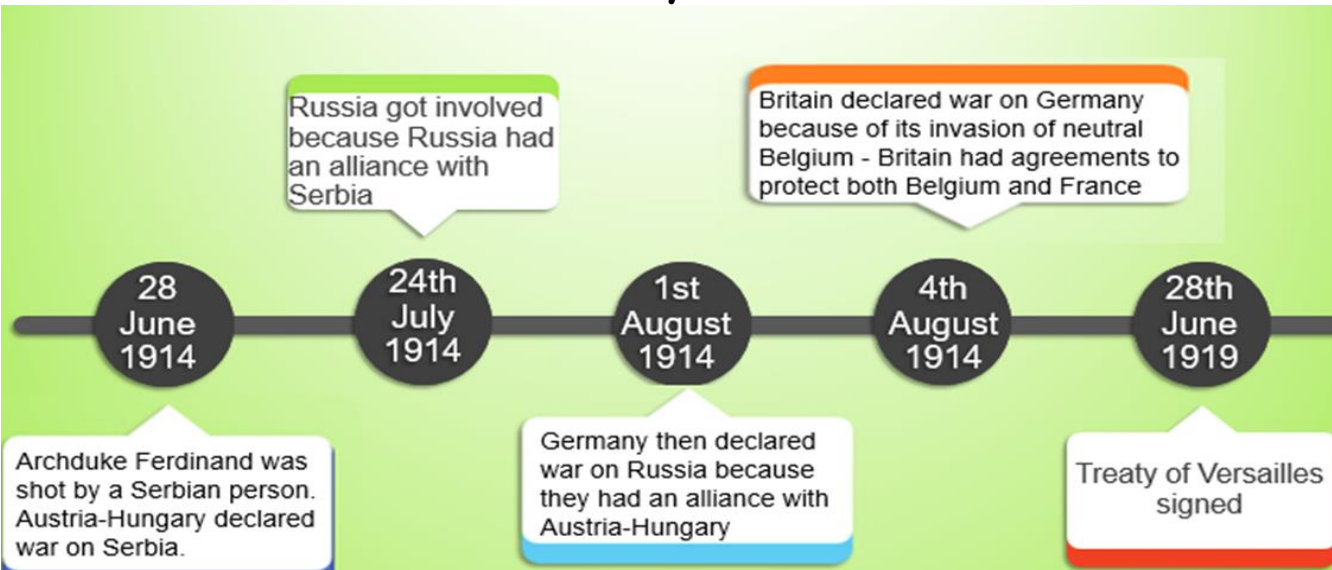
**What should I already know?**

<b>Armistice</b>	An agreement by countries at war to stop fighting..
<b>Army</b>	People who fight on land.
<b>Assassinated</b>	The act of murdering a person.
<b>Colonised</b>	One country taking control of another country.
<b>Navy</b>	People who fight on the seas.
<b>Treaty of Versailles</b>	The peace agreement which brought the war to an end.
<b>Trenches</b>	Long, narrow ditches dug into the ground.
