

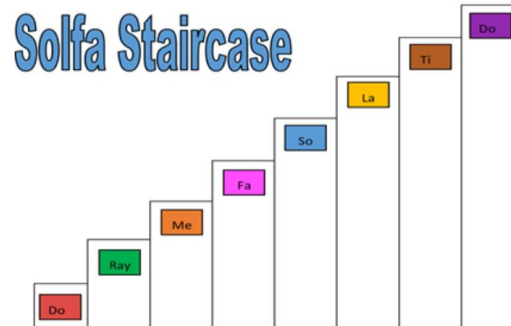


What should I already know?

- I can sing and maintain an independent part
- I can experiment and perform sounds made by my voice
- I can follow and perform a vocal piece using a graphic / notated score

Key knowledge

- Harmony is where more than one pitch or note is sung or played at the same time to create a blended sound or mood
- Pitch can be lowered or raised
- Scales are sets or groups of notes which are ordered by their pitch. You can get scales which are ascending or descending
- Do Ray Me Fa So La Ti Do are the names for notes in a Solfa scale
- Graphic scores are a way of writing down a piece of music so it can be read back and performed correctly
- When performing with the voice, especially in a group, there are some important things to remember:
 - clear and loud
 - accurate pitch
 - keep in time
 - work as a team to start and finish at the right points
 - use sensible dynamics
 - follow performance directions



Key Vocabulary

Harmony - arrangement of parts, combination of tones

Pulse - the regular 'heartbeat' of a piece, holding the core timing together in a piece of music

Scale - a set of ordered musical notes

Tempo - the speed at which a piece of music is played
