## What should I already know?

- Sounds come from a source.
- Sounds are made by vibrations
- We hear sounds through our ears
- The closer we are to the source of the sound the louder it is.
- The further away from the source of the sound, the quieter it seems.

Pitch	How high or low a sound is.	
Vibrate	When something moves up and down or from side to side very quickly.	
Frequency	The number of sound waves produced by a sound source in a certain time	
Source	The object or place where a sound starts or is created from	
Sound wave	The way in which sounds (vibrations) travel through either, solids, liquids or gases.	

High Pitch	<ul> <li>Sound waves travel faster.</li> <li>They vibrate faster.</li> <li>Many sound waves are produced</li> <li>Wave lengths are shorter.</li> </ul>	High pitch
Low Pitch	<ul> <li>Sound waves travel slower.</li> <li>They vibrate slower.</li> <li>Fewer sound waves are produced.</li> <li>Wave lengths are longer</li> </ul>	Low pitch

## Facts about sound

- When an object vibrates, sounds are made.
- These sounds travel in waves known as sound waves.
- Faster and shorter waves create high pitch sounds.
- Slower and longer waves create low pitch sounds.
