




What should I already know?

<u>The Quran</u>

Muslims believe that God shares he word through:

- The Prophet Muhammad as the Messenger
- The Holy Quran as the message

Muslim will read the Quran for guidance and teachings on how to live. The Prophet Muhammad taught people the Qur'an and that there is only one God, Allah, who created everything.

Absolution	Before prayer, Muslims perform ritual washing, or
area	'wudu' in the ablutions area.
Mihrab	A semi-circle in the wall of a mosque that indicates
	the direction of Mecca.
Recompense	To make amends for loss or harm
