What are SATs?

- Children are tested to show what they have learned during their time in Key Stage 2.
- Results capture a snapshot of pupil attainment at the end of their time in Primary School.
- This year, children are formally tested in English (Reading, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and Maths.
- Science and Writing are assessed by class teachers.
- In line with the new National Curriculum there will be greater demand and challenge.

SATs 2017 Reporting to Parents

You will receive a scaled score for Reading, GPS and Maths:

- 100 indicates an average score (100+ met expected standard)
- Less than 100 is below average (-100 below expected standard)
- More than 100 is above average (110 higher standard)
- For writing you will be informed if your child met the expected standard or not met the expected standard
