	Light source	A light source is anything that makes light, whether natural and artificial. It travels in straight lines.
	TransparentA material that allows light to pass through so things can be clearly seen.	
	Translucent	A material that allows some light to pass through, it does not allow you to see a detailed image.
	Opaque	An opaque material does not allow light to pass through so that things cannot be seen through it.
	Reflect	When light from an object is reflected by a surface, it changes direction. It bounces off the surface at the same angle as it hits it.
	Shadow	A dark area or shape produced by an object blocking rays of light.

	Light appears to travel in straight lines.	We can see objects because light travels from light sources to our eyes or is reflected off objects and then into our eyes.			
	Objects can be seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.	Shadows have the same shape as the object that cast them.
