Grammar

If we use more than one adjective to describe a noun, one goes before and one goes after the noun.

des cheveux longs

some long hair

des longs cheveux brun

some long brown hair.

Nouns

All nouns are either masculine and feminine.

Masculine nouns: we use le or un → un nez

Feminine nouns: we use la or une → une tête

Speaking and listening

Formation of long and short sounds

E.g. ai, et / ay → j'ai, et

des + vowel / dez → des oreilles

des + consonant / day → des cheveux

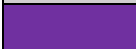
Parts of the face
