Key Facts about the artist

Steven Wiltshire - 1974 -

Steven Wiltshire was born in London in 1978.

When he was young he didn't communicate through speech until he was 5.

He communicated through his drawings.

Steven made a 10m drawing of Hong Kong's Victoria Harbour from memory after a 20-minute helicopter ride.

He uses pen to create detailed drawings.

He is known as a 'human camera' because he can draw an entire city from memory after seeing it once.

Steven's motto is 'Do the best you can and never give up.'

Vocabulary

One point perspective	lines that meet at the same point in the distance.
Urban	town or city
Savant	a person who has a unique talent at something. Usually someone who has Autism
Autism	a person whose brain works differently -this may mean they communicate in a different way to most people. They may have special abilities.
View finder	A frame to help you select a view of what you want to draw
Panoramic view	a wide view
Iconic building	a well-known building, unusually in design or symbolic
