

How will our provision set them up for the future – what benefit will our curriculum be for the children in 25 years?

Our children will build on their map reading skills knowledge – we use globes, atlases, maps and OS maps. They will have a good understanding of the 4 and 8 compass points and will have practised using a compass to navigate. Our children will know that places are connected, through travel, land use and the people that live there. Building on KS1, they will be able to identify human and physical features on maps and photos and how they impact their surroundings.

What do we provide for our children at Overdale?

At Overdale, we provide a bespoke curriculum that is sequenced and knowledge and skills are progressive. Each year group has 3 units, with 6 lessons and these are taught fortnightly over 3 terms. Knowledge Organisers have been created, as a valuable resource to support our learners with key vocabulary and to share the core knowledge they will focusing upon.

What relevant knowledge/skills do our children come to us at Overdale with?

- What a map is and how to use a key
 - 4 points of a compass
- Local area – OIS and where it is located
 - The countries of the UK
- Where the UK is located in the world
 - Names of some oceans
 - Name of some continents
